## **Update**-Two Vehicle Injury Crash

NARRATIVE: The Ford Edge was east on Hwy 27 and the Ford F-250 was south on Highway 18. The Ford Edge entered the intersection, and the Edge struck the F-250 in a "t-bone" manner on the passenger side. Both vehicles entered the east ditch, southeast of the intersection. The F-250 was pulling a small, enclosed trailer and they both rolled. Hwy 18 has the right of way and Highway 27 is posted with a stop sign. All occupants of the Ford Edge were transported via Ambulance to Sanford Hospital in Fargo.
