## SERIOUS INJURY CRASH BY STERLING TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

**What:** Serious Injury Crash/Road Closure

Where: US83 mile marker 64 at the intersection of US83 and 5<sup>th</sup> Ave NE

**When:** 7:30 pm CT

**Road Conditions:** Seasonal, dry

**Weather Conditions:** 84 degrees, no wind reported

**Crash Involvement:** Off-highway motorcycle vs Semi

**Type of Crash:** Right angle

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol

Burleigh County Sheriff's Department

Sterling Rural Fire and Rescue

Metro Ambulance Sanford AirMed

**Vehicle No. 1:** Red 2016 Freightliner Truck, towing belly dump trailer

**Driver No. 1:** 34-year-old male, Devil's Lake, ND

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use

**Charges:** Pending investigation

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2008 Yamaha class 1 off-highway motorcycle

**Driver No. 2:** 21-year-old female, Sterling, ND **Life-Threatening Injuries** 

**Restraints:** Helmet in use

**Charges:** Pending investigation

## NARRATIVE:

A 2008 Yamaha off-highway motorcycle ("dirt bike"), driven by a 21-year-old female, was traveling in the west ditch of US83 near 5<sup>th</sup> Ave NE, on the south side of Sterling. The driver



attempted to cross US83 to the east at 5<sup>th</sup> Ave NE. A 2016 Freightliner was traveling south on US83 loaded with gravel when the motorcycle entered the roadway. The semi was unable to stop when the motorcycle entered the southbound lane, striking the motorcycle on the left side. The female driver was airlifted by Sanford AirMed to Sanford in Bismarck with severe, life-threatening injuries. The female driver was wearing a helmet. The driver of the semi was not injured. This crash is currently under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.

US Highway 83 will be closed on the south side of Sterling until the scene can be cleared. Motorists should plan for an alternative route.

The road is estimated to be reopened by 11:00pm CT on Sunday July 28th. A press release will be sent when the road is open.
