Motorcycle Injury Crash on Sheyenne Street

What: Injury

Where: 3300 Block of Sheyenne Street (West Fargo, ND).

When: June 28th, 2024, at approximately 5:02 PM Central Time

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Sunny

Crash Involvement: Vehicle:

Type of Crash: Fixed Object

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, West Fargo Police Department, West Fargo Fire, Sanford Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2023 Kawasaki Motorcycle

Driver No. 1: Brandon Sorenson-31-year-old male from Fargo, ND. Serious-nonlife-threatening injuries.

Restraints: helmet

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: On June 28th, 2024, at approximately 5:02 PM a seriously injured crash involving a motorcycle occurred on the 3300 block of Sheyenne Street in West Fargo, ND.

The Kawasaki Motorcycle being operated by Brandon Sorenson was travelling southbound on Sheyenne Street at reported high rate of speed. Sorenson lost control of his motorcycle as he rounded a curve, jumped the curb, and entered the west ditch/sidewalk of Sheyenne Street. Sorenson was thrown from the motorcycle and struck a tree. The motorcycle came to rest on its side in the west ditch of Sheyenne Street.

Sorenson sustained serious, non-life-threatening injuries from the crash, and was transported by ambulance to the Sanford Hospital. This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakotah Highway Patrol.
