I am thrilled to share our 2024 Impact Report, highlighting the transformative progress that is taking shape at Mount Desert Island Hospital, thanks to your support. Together, we are building a bolder, brighter future for healthcare in Downeast Maine. Our campus expansion and strategic planning efforts are at the forefront of this transformation.

While other hospitals have reduced services, MDI Hospital is actively recruiting new providers and specialists to meet growing demand, continuing to build capacity with strategic priorities in medical education, workforce stability, and housing. A new Central Utility Plant, set to be completed in early 2025, will improve ventilation, upgrade mechanical systems, and enhance energy efficiency, reducing reliance on fossil fuels, and powering future growth and expansion.

Completion of the new Kogod Center for Medical Education provides much-needed housing for students and residents who are critical to our staffing model. Planning is currently underway for a significant expansion of our Emergency Department (ED) to provide 16 modern patient care rooms, improved privacy, dedicated behavioral health and isolation rooms, and a

new covered ambulance bay. With \$5 million in federal funding secured for our ED by U.S. Senators Susan Collins and Angus King, and the incredible support of our community, we are poised to provide even better emergency care to our community.

Behavioral health remains a key priority, and we are steadfast in our dedication to expanding access to mental health services in our region, particularly for children and young adults. By increasing staffing and innovating treatment resources, we are addressing acute behavioral health needs and the growing incidence of substance use disorders.

Every story in this report describes advancements and care made possible by donors like you. Thank you for supporting MDI Hospital at this pivotal time in our history, and for sharing our vision for a healthier future.

Training the Next Generation of Caregivers

Every day at MDI Hospital, medical education students are working alongside mentors to experience rural medicine firsthand, thanks to friends and donors, like you. These students include aspiring physicians, physician's assistants, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, midwives, pharmacists, certified nursing assistants, dentists, and music therapists. Our medical rotations include such specialties as family medicine, surgery, obstetrics, psychiatry, and emergency medicine. For 2024, the Hospital is on track to host 42 students.

In May, Dr. Nate Donaldson succeeded Dr. Julian Kuffler as Director of Medical Education. A board-certified emergency physician who previously served as Director of MDI Hospital's Emergency Department, Dr. Donaldson often worked side-by-side with many medical residents and other aspiring caregivers, giving him firsthand insight into this program's strengths and potential. In his new role, he says, "I am really enjoying working with our various students as they take on the

enormous challenge of learning medicine."

"It is awesome to be involved in something that really can make a difference in the lives of others," adds Program Coordinator Ann Worrick. "The ability to influence the education of the future providers as well as influence the healthcare opportunities in communities is very gratifying."

MDI Hospital's Medical Education staff sets the pace—interfacing with university and hospital partners, recruiting and welcoming students to Bar Harbor, and collaborating with Hospital colleagues to best meet our patients' needs. The mentors and preceptors who train students in their clinical settings are the heart of this program, and the program's benefits go both ways. As Dr. Julian Weinstein says, "It's always a pleasure to have an inquiring young mind questioning your actions. It helps to keep me on my toes and up-to-date-with all the latest guidelines. It's truly an honor to be involved with the education of new physicians."

On August 13, 2024, MDI Hospital celebrated the grand opening of the Kogod Center for Medical Education with a special ribbon-cutting ceremony honoring the Kogod family. This new construction was made possible by a \$3M transformational gift from Bob and Arlene Kogod. With eight dedicated rooms, the Kogod Center provides housing for more than 60 medical education students and residents per season who come to MDI Hospital for their rural rotations ranging from two-weeks to nine months.

Ninety-eight percent of all residency training in the U.S. is in urban centers, and students tend to take jobs within 100 miles of where they trained, says Dr. Donaldson. This leads to a system where students are pushed toward practicing in urban locations. “With our rotations at MDI Hospital, we expose students to rural medicine and rural life so that they may choose this option when they are finished with training. This can benefit students, as well as the rural community they may ultimately serve.”

“I am proud of the fact that we are recognized by partners like Penn Medicine, Tufts and UNE for providing such fantastic, well-rounded education to their students,” states Dr. Donaldson. “So many of our prospective student inquiries are from individuals that have heard from their peers about what an incredible place this is to come. And our community is benefitting from some of the ‘best and brightest’ minds assisting in their healthcare.”

Your Impact: Fiscal Year 2024 Highlights



A New Home for Medical Education

Construction of the new Kogod Center for Medical Education, funded by a transformational \$3M gift from Arlene and Robert Kogod, was completed at the close of FY24. The Kogod Center will house more than 60 medical education students per season who visit MDI Hospital for their rural rotations. Constructed with sustainability and climate resiliency in mind, the Kogod Center is the first of a series of major campus upgrades planned at MDI Hospital.



Building Capacity

Construction is underway on our new Central Utility Plant (CUP) building to upgrade and modernize aging mechanicals with greener, more efficient technology capable of powering future expansion. Once completed in early 2025, this project will greatly improve MDI Hospital's ventilation, heating, and electrical infrastructure; maximize energy efficiency; reduce reliance on fossil fuels; and serve as the platform for modern medical technologies and equipment.



Expanding Infrastructure

Campus expansion planning to renovate and expand the Hospital's Emergency Department, a lifesaving safety net for this community, progressed in FY24 with a significant \$5M award announced by U.S. Senator Susan Collins, vice chair of the Senate Appropriations Committee, and U.S. Senator Angus King. This project will expand the current ED to three times its current size. Plans also include upgrades to the hospital's surgical suites and a new, more accessible main entrance from Bar Harbor's Main Street.

As an independent, not-for-profit community hospital, Mount Desert Island Hospital exists to serve the people of MDI & Hancock County. We are immensely grateful to YOU—our dedicated community, donors, and friends for all you do to advance the health and well-being of MDI. You help ensure that MDI Hospital is here to deliver expert, compassionate primary, specialty, and emergency care to all who need it—when they need it most.

Prioritizing Behavioral Health

Following the pandemic, the CDC has tracked a rise in substance use, anxiety, depression, adolescent suicide, and eating disorders, among others. Our ongoing response includes increased staffing for all ages, enhanced child/adolescent therapy support, the co-founding of the MDI Regional Wellness Coalition, and substance use disorder treatment partnerships with Healthy Acadia and other regional agencies.



Designer Showhouse at Hamilton Hill

Established by Creative Director Kim Swan, the unique Designer Showhouse series partners property owners with home designers to create artistic and imaginative spaces that are opened for tours to the public to benefit local charities.

During the summer of FY24, Hamilton Hill welcomed more than 1,500 visitors and raised more than \$75,000 in support of MDI Hospital's vital programs and services.



Tobacco Treatment & Prevention

Last September, the Maine Cancer Foundation issued a one-year, \$12,966 grant to help establish a new Tobacco Treatment and Prevention Program, with additional support from the Hattie A. and Fred C. Lynam Trust. Our Health Coaches are engaging with community partners to achieve the long-term goal of making a positive, multi-generational impact on our region's persistently high rates of cigarette smoking. Key to this plan is a free, 7-week group class, which provides a structured, systematic approach to quitting smoking.



Fighting His Way Through: Wyatt's Story

It was a normal winter day in February for Wyatt Fountaine, a seventh grader at Connors Emerson School in Bar Harbor, when he started down the stairs to head to basketball practice. But suddenly, Wyatt felt a pain in his chest and collapsed into his mother Stephanie's arms. Fearing the worst, she rushed Wyatt to Mount Desert Island Hospital's Emergency Department, where a healthcare team was waiting for them.

Within thirty minutes of arriving at MDI Hospital, the Fountaine family learned that Wyatt had a collapsed lung and needed emergency surgery. In the operating room, Dr. Charlie Hendricks inserted a chest tube to re-expand the lung and allow Wyatt to breathe again. "It was every parent's worst nightmare; we have never been so scared," recalled Stephanie.

Following the surgery, Wyatt remained in the Hospital's Intensive Care Unit for evaluation. He was diagnosed with sporadic pneumothorax – or a collapsed lung that occurs without an obvious cause – which mainly occurs in male athletes ages 20 to 30 years old, making Wyatt's case unusual at 12 years of age. He also tested positive for COVID-19, requiring a period of isolation.

During his isolation, Wyatt endured painful breathing exercises every hour to help strengthen his lungs. Dr. Hendricks brought comfort during his twice-daily rounds, and the ICU nurses were so kind, said Stephanie. Wyatt never had to wait for his medication, and he always knew what to expect or what would happen next. "They were beyond amazing and kept his spirits high."

On July 20, more than 250 guests gathered at the home of Ruth Marie Colket for MDI Hospital's 2024 Benefit Dinner. During remarks, Wyatt Fountaine bravely shared his story of the lifesaving care he received at MDI Hospital. As a result of the generosity of supporters and friends, this year's event raised a remarkable \$603,000 in support of the Hospital's vital programs and services, making a significant impact for everyone in the Mount Desert Island community.

Being isolated in the ICU is hard for anyone, said Hannah Cote, RN, Nursing Supervisor at MDI Hospital, but as a middle school student who is missing school, his friends, and his passion, basketball, it can be even harder. “He didn’t complain at all,” said Cote. “I was so impressed by this young man.” Teachers, staff, teammates, and friends kept in close contact during his extended hospital stay. In turn, Wyatt made posters and sent videos to cheer them on during playoff season.

As Wyatt’s condition improved, Dr. Hendricks ordered a final CT Scan to confirm his progress. During the scan, Wyatt’s lung suddenly collapsed again, and he was rushed into a second emergency surgery. This time, Dr. Hendricks enlisted the help of a pediatric pulmonologist via Zoom. “Wyatt had a completely collapsed lung that could have led to a cardiovascular collapse. It was life-threatening and if not for MDI Hospital, he may not have made it to another institution,” said Dr. Hendricks.

After the successful second surgery, Wyatt was referred to a pediatric thoracic surgeon, and MDI Hospital staff made arrangements for transport to the Barbara Bush Children’s Hospital in Portland, Maine. As he traveled to Portland via ambulance, Wyatt’s undefeated basketball team was playing in their league’s championship game.

Wyatt wanted more than anything to be on that court

with his team, but he was happy to be able to watch it from inside the ambulance and cheer them on with two EMTs. “I could see the blood pressure and heart monitor gauges rising and falling as he got excited about each basket that was made,” said Stephanie. “I was terrified!” Wyatt’s team won the championship and dedicated the game to him.

Today, Wyatt is thriving. Back on the basketball court three weeks after being discharged from the hospital, Wyatt decided that he was not going to let fear stop him from playing the game he is so passionate about. And he hasn’t stopped since. In the last year, Wyatt has spent at least six days per week on the basketball court, training and lending his time to coach younger players at the MDI YMCA. Recently, Wyatt competed in a speaking contest at his school, delivering a speech on the theme of fighting his way through.

When asked how this experience has affected him, he said, “I am mentally stronger, and I know I can fight through hard things. I had to have a lot of faith in myself that I could make a full recovery, and I had to have a lot of faith in the doctors, too.”

“His lungs are 100% and he is healthy as a horse,” said Stephanie. “We can’t thank MDI Hospital enough for everything they did for Wyatt and our family.”

Healthcare Partner of the Year: Good Shepherd Food Bank

Food insecurity has been shown to increase the risk of common health problems like type 2 diabetes, hypertension, and heart disease. Good Shepherd Food Bank is a leader in addressing food insecurity in the healthcare setting in Hancock County, where one in seven don't have access to enough nutritious food to maintain a healthy lifestyle. Since 2019, Good Shepherd has partnered with MDI Hospital and Health Centers to help provide free nutrient-dense, shelf-stable food bags in the clinic setting. As the program developed, clinic nurses noticed that having to self-disclose as food insecure was a barrier for their patients. Good Shepherd immediately stepped up to stock “help yourself shelves” where anyone in need of food may take a bag, no questions asked. This led to remarkable success as essential items flew off the shelves, catering to more local patients and their families than ever before. Their support extended even further with the implementation of rotating monthly “Produce Pop-Ups” at MDI Hospital and Health Centers to ensure access to fresh produce for all community members in need. Through these efforts, Good Shepherd is helping to underscore the fundamental link between nutrition and healthcare, leveraging grants and community support to enact meaningful change and provide vital assistance to families across our region.

As President of College of the Atlantic from 2011 to 2024, Darron Collins has made an enduring impact on the health and vibrancy of Mount Desert Island. 


