The Texas Film Commission has designated Cedar Park as the inaugural Digital Media Friendly Texas Certified Community, marking a significant milestone in the City's commitment to fostering innovation and economic development.

Through the Digital Media Friendly Texas Certification process, the City of Cedar Park is in a strong position to "attract business opportunities by showing these creative professionals and companies that your community is a step ahead of the rest and is ready for those highly skilled and highly paid jobs," stated Matt Miller, Digital Media Production Consultant with the Texas Film Commission.
