

EXTENSION OF DISASTER DECLARATION

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of July 2024, the Mayor issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City of Pasadena, Texas, resulting from Hurricane Beryl.

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of the state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASADENA, TEXAS:

- 1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for the City of Pasadena, Texas, by the Mayor on the 7th day of July 2024, shall continue for a period not to exceed 60 days unless sooner terminated by order of the City Council.
- 2. This Resolution is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to Section 10-2 of the Pasadena Code of Ordinances and shall become effective on this the 12th day of July 2024.
