MAYOR'S AWARD OF EXCELLENCE RECIPIENTS

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – Mayor Larry Klein presented the special Mayor's Awards of Excellence at the State of the City celebration on Sept. 21. By tradition, these award winners are not revealed until the ceremony. The 2024 recipients are:

- Janet Camp, Award of Excellence (Individual) A Sunnyvale resident since 1962, Jan was a beloved teacher in Sunnyvale middle schools for more than 35 years and devoted volunteer for more than 40 years. She founded two local charitable organizations FISH and Our Daily Bread that support those in need. She also served in numerous volunteer roles for the Sunnyvale Historical Society, including multiple terms as president. And she was instrumental in raising the funds to build Sunnyvale's Heritage Park Museum. "Few can match Jan's heart, her drive, her constant smile and her passion for our city," said Mayor Klein.
- Sunnyvale Rotary Club, Award of Excellence (Group) The dedicated volunteers with the Sunnyvale Rotary Club have been making a difference in our community since 1926. Their numerous projects support education, feeding families in need, improving the environment, and supporting our local nonprofits. A central focus is literacy. They have donated countless books to elementary and middle schools, and visit classrooms to read books to school children. They also sponsor several popular events that raise funds to support their activities, including the annual crab feed, Dinner at the Dump, and golf tournaments. "Sunnyvale Rotary has made a positive impact in our community for almost 100 years and we're grateful for their unwavering commitment to Sunnyvale," said Mayor Klein.
