Dear Residents and Business Owners:

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has declared a drought watch for all of Westchester County due to a significant shortage of rainfall and declining levels of steamfall and groundwater.

We are currently in a **Restriction Stage 1 Drought Watch/Emergency**. To protect water resources, homeowners and businesses in regions under drought watch are encouraged to abide by the following restrictions:

- 1. Industrial/Commercial users must reduce their water consumption by 15%.
- 2. Time spent on lawn watering must be reduced to 4 hours per day. We advise the public to follow the Odd/Even schedule below:
 - Odd House Numbers: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday
 - Even House Numbers: Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday

This drought watch declaration will remain in effect until the DEC lifts the watch.
