ELGIN RESIDENT CLAIMS \$1 MILLION SCRATCH TICKET PRIZE

AUSTIN – An Elgin resident claimed a top prize winning ticket worth \$1 million in the Texas Lottery® scratch ticket game [Lucky Millions](#). The ticket was purchased at Elgin Quick Mart, located at 13717 County Line Road, in Elgin. The claimant elected to remain anonymous.

This was the first of four top prizes worth \$1 million to be claimed in this game. Lucky Millions offers more than \$94 million in total prizes. Overall odds of winning any prize in the game are one in 3.99, including break-even prizes.
