## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER PERTAINING TO THE REASSIGNMENT OF CASES PURSUANT TO THE APPOINTMENT OF <a href="https://doi.org/10.1007/j.com/">THE HONORABLE PAUL R. HAGE</a>

On September 20, 2024, the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit appointed Paul R. Hage to serve as a United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Eastern District of Michigan sitting in Detroit, effective September 30, 2024. Judge Hage has been appointed to fill the vacancy of Judge Thomas J. Tucker, who continues to serve full time on a recall basis. To implement the assignment of cases to Judge Hage, this administrative order is entered pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 154(b) and E.D. Mich. LBR 1073-1(c)(2). Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, as soon as reasonably practicable after 5:00 p.m. on the date of entry of this order:

- 1. The Clerk of Court will reassign all pending chapter 13 cases currently assigned to Judge Oxholm, including all associated pending adversary proceedings, to Judge Hage, except for those cases and adversary proceedings listed on Exhibit A of this Order.
- 2. The Clerk of Court will reassign all pending chapter 13 cases currently assigned to Judge Tucker, including all associated pending adversary proceedings, to Judge Oxholm, except for those cases and adversary proceedings listed on Exhibit B of this Order.
- 3. The Clerk of Court, using the Court's blind draw system, will assign all newly filed Detroit chapter 13 cases equally to Judge Randon, Judge Oxholm, Judge Gretchko, and Judge Hage.

- 4. The Clerk of Court, using the Court's blind draw system, will assign all newly filed Detroit chapter 11, chapter 12, and chapter 15 cases equally to Judge Tucker, Judge Randon, Judge Oxholm, Judge Gretchko, and Judge Hage.
- 5. The Clerk of Court, using the Court's blind draw system, will assign Judge Tucker 28% of all newly filed Detroit chapter 7 cases, Judge Randon 18% of all newly filed Detroit chapter 7 cases, Judge Oxholm 18% of all newly filed Detroit chapter 7 cases, Judge Gretchko 18% of all newly filed Detroit chapter 7 cases, and Judge Hage 18% of all newly filed Detroit chapter 7 cases.
