Changes to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and Forms December 1, 2024

On December 1, 2024, the following Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Official Bankruptcy Forms, and Director's Bankruptcy Forms will be amended:

- Bankruptcy Rules 1007, 4004, 5009, 7001, 8023.1 (new rule), and 9006;
- Official Form 410; and
- Director's Forms 1040, 2000, and 2630.

Note Regarding Bankruptcy Rule 1007 and Official Form 423:

Official Form 423 Certification About a Financial Management Course will be abrogated. Rule 1007(b)(7) will require an individual debtor who has completed an instructional course concerning personal financial management to file the certificate of course completion issued by the approved provider of that course, if the provider has not already notified the court that the debtor has completed the course. Effective December 1, 2024, the certificate of course completion must be filed in lieu of Official Form 423.
