Applications to Waive Chapter 7 Filing Fee

When requesting a waiver of a Chapter 7 filing fee, keep in mind 28 U.S.C. §1930(f)(1) provides a court may waive the fee if it determines an individual debtor "has income less than 150 percent of the income official poverty line" **and** "is unable to pay that fee in installments." In deciding whether a debtor is unable to pay the filing fee in installments, the Court considers the debtor's current income and expenses **and any assets listed on the debtor's schedules**. It is important to set forth in section 5 of the Application to Have the Chapter 7 Filing Fee Waived (Official Form 103B) why the debtor is "unable to pay the filing fee in installments within 120 days."
