Sacramento Superior Court Set to Conduct Evacuation Drill Downtown

Sacramento, CA—The Sacramento Superior Court will conduct a drill at two downtown locations at 9:30 a.m. Monday, Oct. 14, to practice safe evacuation procedures during a simulated incident.

The drill will take place at the following locations:

- Gordon D. Schaber Courthouse at 720 9th Street
- Hall of Justice at 813 6th Street

Signage will be posted outside both buildings, alerting the public of the planned drill. Emergency personnel and vehicles with flashing lights may be present while court facilities are temporarily evacuated.

The evacuation drill is anticipated to have minimal impact on court operations. During the drill, members of the public are requested to follow the instructions of uniformed court security officers and designated staff members who will be wearing reflective vests.

Court operations will resume following the brief drill.

Those individuals with court proceedings or jury duty on Monday, Oct. 14, should report to the court as scheduled. Failure to appear for a scheduled court date could result in a judge issuing an arrest warrant.

Courtrooms and court staff in the Sacramento County Mail Jail will not participate in the drill.
