

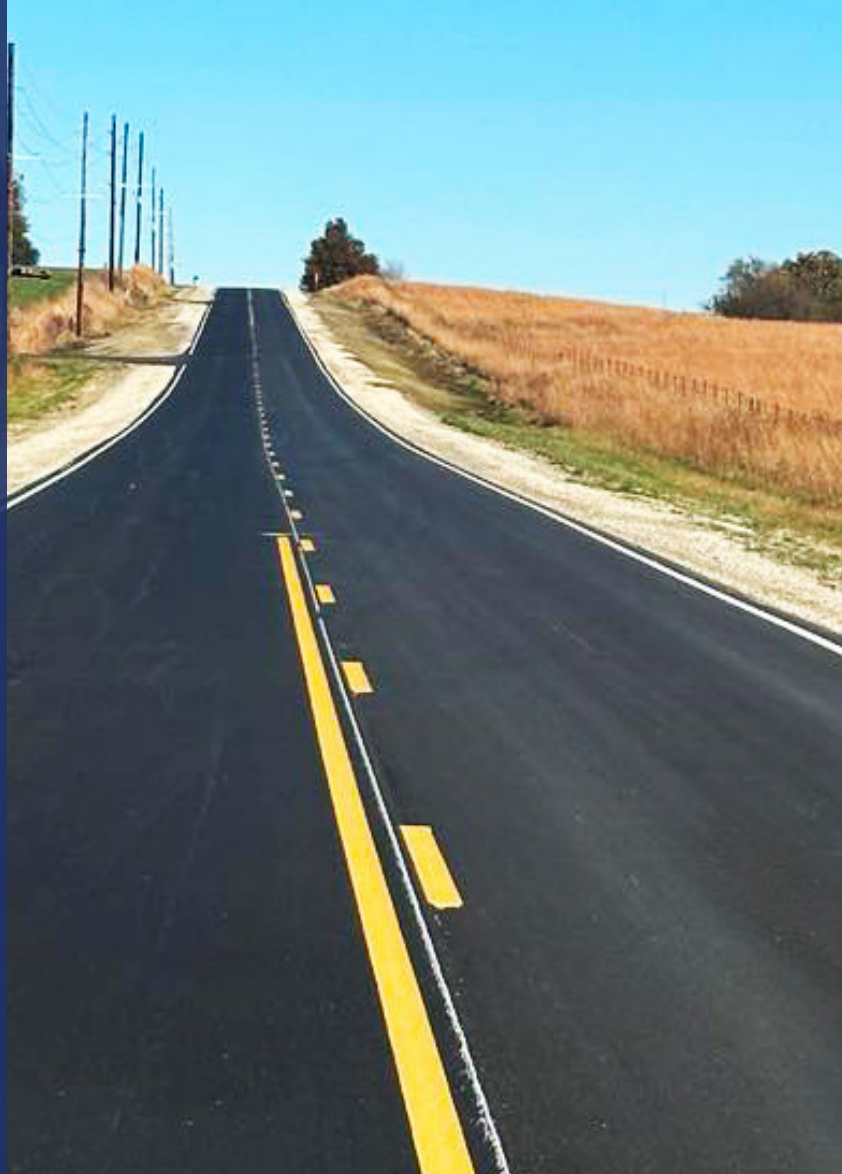


# Old 50 Highway Improvement Project

### About the Project

This four-month project consisted of widening Old Highway 50 from 20 feet to 24 feet, which included extending all culvert structures to support the wider road. The existing asphalt was milled and reused as base material. Additional enhancements were made along the remaining 12 miles of Old Highway 50, reaching the Coffey County line and Dane Street in Williamsburg, which included a 1¼-inch overlay.

The project was a success, thanks to excellent construction and design work, as well as key contributions from Franklin County Public Works Crews in widening, right-of-way work, and drainage improvements.
