Chamblee Police Department Announce National Night Out Event

July 23, 2024 — The Chamblee Police Department (CPD), through the CPD Neighborhood Resource Unit (NRU), is excited to announce its participation in National Night Out (NNO), a nationwide celebration and awareness of crime prevention, on **Tuesday, August 6th, from 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. at the Chamblee Police Department (4445 Buford Hwy, Chamblee, GA 30341).** CPD is encouraging the community to join them for an evening of fun with family, friends, neighbors, and city leaders as they promote police-community partnerships and build neighborhood camaraderie.

"National Night Out is a great way for our community to come together, build relationships and earn trust," said Chamblee Police Chief Michael Dieppa. "We encourage everyone to join us for an evening of fun, learning, and unity."

This family-friendly event is open to all residents and will feature a variety of activities, including:

- Meet and Greet with Local Law Enforcement Officers
- Safety Demonstrations and Educational Exhibits
- Music, Free food, and Games

The Chamblee Municipal Court will also conduct their Amnesty Program at National Night Out. Individuals will be allowed to resolve past-due traffic citations and/or active bench warrants for failing to appear in court. The court will waive contempt fees for failure to appear for individuals who pay their fines. Individuals with citations that require a mandatory court appearance will have the opportunity to receive a future court date, have warrants cleared, and/or granted license release forms upon posting of a cash bond without the fear of being arrested. Individuals requesting amnesty will need to bring acceptable forms of identification such as a driver's license or passport. For more information, visit www.chambleega.com

NNO will also be the initiation date of the CPD Bicycle and Scooter Registration Program. Residents and businesses will be able to register their bikes and scooters online through the city website. However, an officer will be on-site during NNO to assist anyone with this registration.
