Chamblee to Host Babe Walls Mural Festival

Four-Day Festival Celebrates Women and Non-Binary Artists

October 8, 2024 — The City of Chamblee is proud to announce its partnership with Babe Walls to bring a vibrant four-day mural festival to Chamblee on November 7-10, 2024. Stretching along the Chamblee Rail Trail from the Keswick Softball Field and the Clairmont Bridge piano (behind Walmart), a diverse group of 30 artists will come together to celebrate women and non-binary folk through the transformative power of public art on 20 murals. This free and unique festival will feature live mural creation, artsy vendors, and a variety of food trucks. Attendees will witness the artistic process in real-time as artists collaborate to create stunning, large-scale works of art that will add color and vibrancy to the Chamblee community.

"We are thrilled to partner with the non-profit Babe Walls and to welcome so many talented mural artists to our community," said Teneisha Jones, Chamblee's Public Art Coordinator. "By the end of the four-day event, we will have an accessible outdoor museum of street art for everyone to enjoy."

Babe Walls is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that supports and celebrates women and non-binary artists worldwide with the celebration of community. Festivalgoers are encouraged to walk the Chamblee Rail Trail and watch the process, enjoy the Artist Market, and take photos.
