Began handling pellets made from recycled marine plastic waste washed ashore in Tsushima City, Nagasaki Prefecture

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Hamee Corp. (Head Office: Odawara City, Kanagawa Prefecture, President and CEO: Ikuhiro Mizushima, Securities Code 3134: TSE Standard Market) announced that its Recycled Plastics Exchange, an online shopping mall that connects businesses that want to sell and businesses that want to buy recycled plastics, will begin handling "Re:Ocean@TSUSHIMA" (manufacturer: Seiko International Co., Ltd.), a plastic pellet made from 100% recycled marine plastic waste washed ashore in Tsushima City, Nagasaki Prefecture. 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■ About the Recycled Plastics Exchange

This is an online shopping mall operated by Hamee, which deals in smartphone accessories, etc., for the trading of recycled plastic materials between businesses. Listed companies can list plastic scraps generated during the manufacturing process, plastic products that remain sleepy in warehouses, and other items for free. The purchasing company can purchase the required amount of recycled plastics of the desired materials and colors.

- Membership registration (free) is required for use.
- **Only recycled materials can be listed. Virgin plastic materials are not available for listing.

■ Background to operating the Recycled Plastics Exchange

We Hamee developed a service "ParallelPlastics" that transforms plastic products that are no longer needed into new products in order to effectively utilize plastics. One of the challenges we have identified in developing our services is the difficulty of obtaining recycled plastic materials.

In recent years, there has been an increase in the number of cases which recycled plastic materials are used, mainly by global companies. However, information on the disposal and storage of plastic products that are used as raw materials is not publicly available, so it is difficult to find desired materials or recycled plastic materials with colors when needed. On the other hand, despite the fact that there are still ways to use them, there are many plastics that are burned as fuels without finding ways to use them effectively.

Against this background, we opened "Recycled Plastics Exchange." We connect the demand and supply of businesses with plastic products that have nowhere to go and manufacturing businesses that need the plastic products to accelerate domestic plastic circulation.

■ About "Re:Ocean@TSUSHIMA"



In Tsushima City, Nagasaki Prefecture, a huge amount of marine waste drifts from overseas every year due to the overlap of location, ocean currents, seasonal wind, and topographical conditions. The estimates range from about 20,000 to 30,000 m² per year. Of these, only about a quarter (approximately 8,000 cubic meters) of the city's total annual collection volume.

"Re:Ocean@TSUSHIMA" is a recycled plastic pellet made by Seiko International Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director: Huang Jinlian) that recycles these marine plastic waste.

In April 2024, we began manufacturing and sales as a direct measure to reduce marine waste, with the desire to "clean Tsushima's sea with the power of business." Offshore plastic waste sorted by "type" and "color" is re-pelleted and provided to outdoor manufacturers and other manufacturers as materials for plastic products.

In an effort to reduce and effectively utilize more marine waste, we have decided to begin handling "Re:Ocean@TSUSHIMA" on "the Recycled Plastics Exchange", an online shopping mall.

Fishing net regeneration material
Original product: fishing net
Exhibitor: REMARE Inc.

Listed by REMARE Inc., which engages in material recycling of marine plastics and difficult-to-dispose plastics discharged by companies. This is a reclaimed pellet made by recycling fishery waste, which is said to account for 60% of marine waste.



Smartphone case milling material
Original product: Smartphone case

Listed by Hamee Corp., a manufacturer that handles mobile accessories such as iFace. This is a pulverized material made by crushing unsold in-house smartphone cases.
