NOW, BASED UPON THE FOREGOING, AND GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, it is hereby ORDERED, under the provisions of Corporations Code section 25249, that Paul Francis Chamberlin d.b.a. Chamberlin Asset Management discontinue the following violations: (1) Corporations Code section 25241(a); (2) California Code of Regulations, title 10, section 260.241.2(a)(3); (3) California Code of Regulations, title 10, section 260.241.3(a)(2)(4)(6); (4) California Code of Regulations, title 10, section 260.236.1(a)(3); and (5) California Code of Regulations, title 10, section 260.241.4(d)(e). The Commissioner finds this action is appropriate, in the public interest, for the protection of investors, and consistent with the purposes fairly intended by the policies and procedures of the CSL.
