Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1449) to amend the Geothermal Steam Act of 1970 to increase the frequency of lease sales, to require replacement sales, and for other purposes, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 9495) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to postpone tax deadlines and reimburse paid late fees for United States nationals who are unlawfully or wrongfully detained or held hostage abroad, to terminate the tax-exempt status of terrorist supporting organizations, and for other purposes.

1 Resolved, That at any time after adoption of this reso-2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1449) to amend the Geothermal Steam Act of 1970 to increase the frequency of lease sales, 6 to require replacement sales, and for other purposes. The 7 8 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-10 11 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Nat-13 ural Resources or their respective designees. After general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be considered as read. 15 All points of order against provisions in the bill are waived. No amendment to the bill shall be in order except those printed in the report of the Committee on Rules ac-19 companying this resolution. Each such amendment may 20 be offered only in the order printed in the report, may 21 be offered only by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to

- 1 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-
- 2 sion of the question in the House or in the Committee
- 3 of the Whole. All points of order against such amendments
- 4 are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
- 5 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
- 6 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been
- 7 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
- 8 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
- 9 without intervening motion except one motion to recom-
- 10 mit.
- 11 Sec. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
- 12 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 9495)
- 13 to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to postpone
- 14 tax deadlines and reimburse paid late fees for United
- 15 States nationals who are unlawfully or wrongfully detained
- 16 or held hostage abroad, to terminate the tax-exempt status
- 17 of terrorist supporting organizations, and for other pur-

- 2 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-
