Decision to Participation in Management and Operation of a Large-Scale Dairy Farm Facility in Namie Town, Fukushima Prefecture

Regarding the public solicitation for the management and operation of a large-scale dairy facility being constructed in Namie town, Fukushima Prefecture, Shine Coast Corporation in which Taiheiyo Cement Corporation (Headquartered in Bunkyo-ku, Tokyo; President and Representative Director: Yoshifumi Taura; hereinafter "the Company") has an equity stake was selected as the preferred bidder and signed an agreement with Namie town on August 28.

In Namie town, the Great East Japan Earthquake and the accident at the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station have reduced the willingness of livestock farmers to manage their farms, and the rate of resumption of farming by pre-disaster livestock farmers has been extremely low. In order to resume farming, it is also necessary to restore the soil fertility of fields that have been degraded by decontamination, so livestock facilities are being built to establish a system to continue farming by promoting arable-livestock cooperation.

By applying the waste and byproduct processing technology the Company have cultivated in the past to the management and operation of large-scale dairy facilities through Shine Coast Corp. in conjunction with our efforts to revitalize agriculture, for example the experimental cultivation of feed crops, the Company aims to contribute to the revitalization of arable livestock in Fukushima and to new resource-recycling dairy facilities management.
