Summary: SCE submits this report as it involves an event that meets the significant public attention and/or media coverage reporting requirement. Preliminary information indicates SCE equipment was involved in the ignition of a brush fire known as the Pauba Fire that consumed approximately 101 acres. Forward progress of the fire was stopped earlier this afternoon and there were no reports of any structures destroyed or damaged. Local media reported two firefighters assigned to the response were taken to Temecula Valley Hospital due to apparent heat stroke and were in stable condition. The investigation is ongoing.
