



Aging **Population**

- Global population over 60 years of age expected to exceed two billion by 2050
- 15% of global population has a disability
- 1 in 3 adults globally have multiple chronic conditions
- These conditions include: congenital (e.g., cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy), acquired (e.g., stroke, spinal cord injury), and degenerative (e.g., ALS, COPD, bariatric, agerelated)
