

A GLITZY HOLLYWOOD-STYLE CELEBRATION HONORS A YOUNG ROLE MODEL IN THE FOURTH EPISODE OF CELEBRATIONS WITH LACEY CHABERT, PREMIERING SEPTEMBER 26 ON HALLMARK+
