Sales and Gross Margin

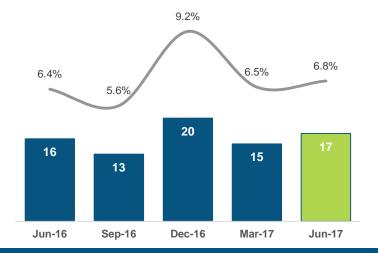

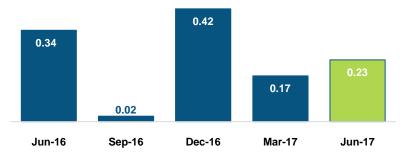
EBITDA and EBITDA Margin

Diluted Earnings Per Share

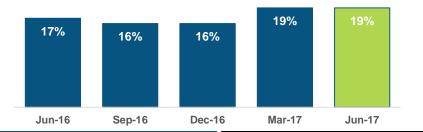

Return on Invested Capital

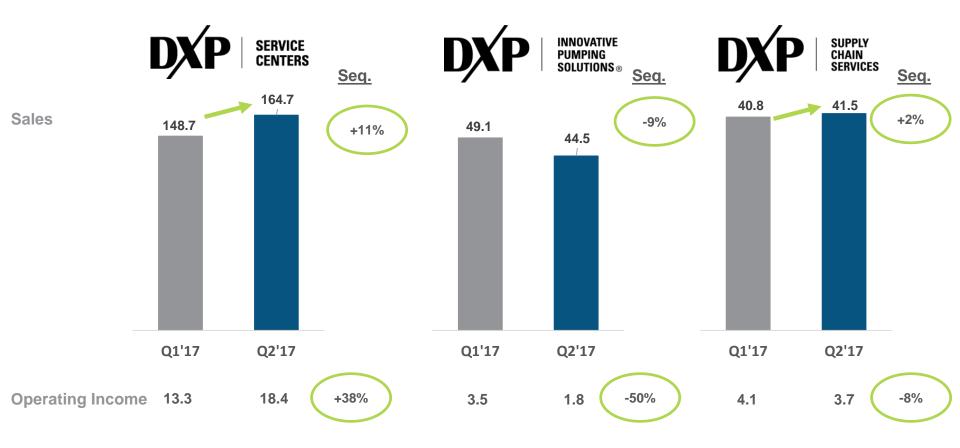

Return on invested capital is defined as tax affected LTM EBITDA / average total net operating assets.



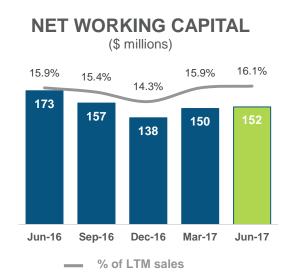

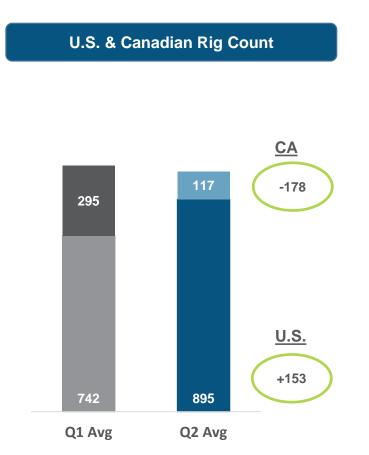

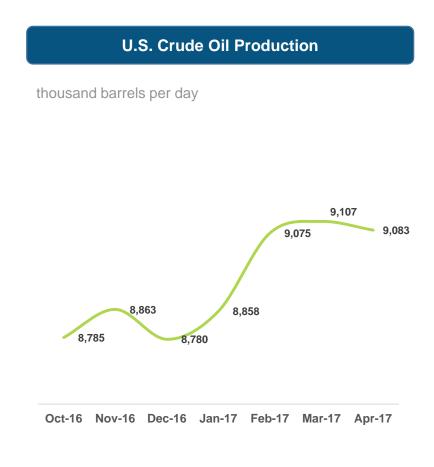

KEY INDICATOR PERFORMANCE



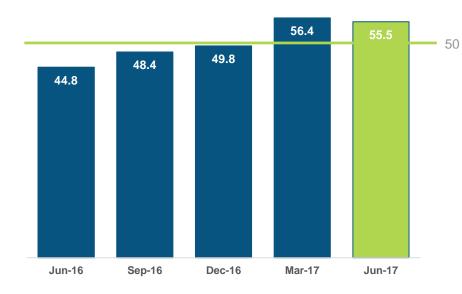
