Every associate and leader who is entrusted with the responsibility to commit the expenditure of funds, directly or indirectly, for the purpose of procuring or sourcing global talent through a vendor shall seek to encourage the participation of diverse businesses by including diverse-owned vendors in their vendor search. Kforce will provide assistance in the search. In this regard, please contact the Supplier Diversity team.

Kforce Global Talent department will:

- Work to identify diverse vendors that procure or source global talent, obtain diversity and certification information during its sourcing and vendor setup process and actively track and store the certifications of all diverse vendors
- Run quarterly spend reporting and analytics that will track our spend with diverse vendors in aggregate, by subsections of diversity type, and by vendor classification to assist us in driving effective diversity spend
- Establish goals to increase minority spend by volume and number of vendors, in coordination with the Kforce objectives and goals
- Track and report on opportunities provided to certified diverse vendors including win/loss ratios Certified diverse vendors are encouraged to navigate to our Supplier Diversity website on Kforce.com to input their information.

Every associate and leader who is entrusted with the responsibility to commit the expenditure of funds, directly or indirectly, for the purchase of goods or services shall seek to encourage participation of diverse businesses by including diverse-owned suppliers in their vendor search. Kforce provides a variety of tools to assist in the search, which include lists of diverse-owned suppliers and membership to a database of diverse-owned suppliers. Educational and technical assistance is offered by our Procurement department and Supplier Diversity team.

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Kforce Procurement department will:

- Work to identify diverse suppliers, obtain diversity and certification information during its sourcing and vendor setup process and actively track and store the certifications of all diverse suppliers
- Run quarterly spend reporting and analytics that will track our spend with diverse suppliers in aggregate, by subsections of diversity type, and by supplier classification to assist us in driving effective diversity spend
- Establish goals to increase minority spend by volume and number of suppliers, in coordination with the Kforce DE&I objectives and goals
- Track and report on opportunities provided to certified diverse suppliers including win/loss ratios
