There was one submission received and it was in favor of the RySG's charter amendments and noted that the RySG's "commitment to continuous improvement strengthens the ICANN multistakeholder model."

Section 4: Analysis of Submissions

The comment received was overwhelmingly supportive of the RySG's charter amendment effort.

Faheem Soomro made a concerted effort to point out that the RySG's "well-defined structure, inclusive membership categories, and adherence to principles of openness, accountability, transparency, inclusiveness, and representativeness" is a credit to the drafting team of the RySG with their amended charter.
