1. Internal migration

- □ The number of internal migrants was 511 thousand persons in August 2024, falling by 5.1% (27 thousand persons) year-on-year.
- ☐ The intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants occupied 65.2% and 34.8% of the total internal migrants in August 2024, respectively.
 - O Compared to August 2023, the intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants fell by 5.7% and 3.9%, respectively.


☐ The internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 11.8%, down 0.6%p year-on-year.

2. Internal migration for metropolitan cities and provinces

- □ Regarding the net migration of metropolitan cities and provinces, 5 regions recorded a plus net migration.: Gyeonggi (6,234 persons), Incheon (1,785 persons), Chungnam (711 persons), etc. On the other hand, 12 regions recorded a minus net migration.: Seoul (-3,848 persons), Busan (-1,460 persons), Gyeongbuk (-799 persons) and so on.
- □ Sejong, Incheon and Gyeonggi recorded a plus net migration rate of 1.5%, 0.7% and 0.5%, respectively. On the other hand, Jeju, Ulsan and Gwangju recorded a minus net migration rate of -0.6%, -0.6% and -0.5%, respectively.
