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Internal Migration in June 2024

- ☐ The number of internal migrants was 440 thousand persons in June 2024, which fell by 7.1% year-on-year.
- ☐ In June 2024, the internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 10.5%, which went down by 0.7%p year-on-year.

1. Internal migration

- ☐ The number of internal migrants was 440 thousand persons in June 2024, falling by 7.1% (34 thousand persons) year-on-year.
- ☐ The intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants occupied 67.3% and 32.7% of the total internal migrants in June 2024, respectively.
 - O Compared to June 2023, the intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants fell by 5.8% and 9.6%, respectively.


☐ The internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 10.5%, down 0.7%p year-on-year.

2. Internal migration for metropolitan cities and provinces

- □ Regarding the net migration of metropolitan cities and provinces, 6 regions recorded a plus net migration.: Gyeonggi (6,490 persons), Incheon (1,196 persons), Chungnam (810 persons), etc. On the other hand, 11 regions recorded a minus net migration.: Seoul (-5,558 persons), Busan (-1,192 persons), Daejeon (-499 persons) and so on.
- ☐ Gyeonggi, Chungbuk and Incheon recorded a plus net migration rate of 0.6%, 0.5% and 0.5%, respectively. On the other hand, Seoul, Busan and Jeju recorded a minus net migration rate of -0.7%, -0.4% and -0.4%, respectively.
