BAGI REGIONAL WORKSHOP ON COMPILING TOURISM STATISTICS IN ASIA AND THE PACIFIC

Malaysia menjadi tuan rumah *Regional Workshop on Compiling Tourism Statistics in Asia and the Pacific*

PUTRAJAYA, 10 Mei 2024 – Malaysia, yang diwakili oleh Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) ditawarkan oleh *Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP)* untuk menjadi tuan rumah *Regional Workshop on Compiling Tourism Statistics in Asia and the Pacific* yang telah diadakan pada 6 hingga 10 Mei 2024. Bengkel tersebut dihadiri oleh 29 delegasi dari negara anggota rantau Asia dan Pasifik iaitu Bangladesh, Bhutan, Kyrgyzstan, Maldives, Mongolia dan Nepal, bersama wakil dari Malaysia. Malaysia diwakili peserta daripada Kementerian Pelancongan, Seni dan Budaya (MOTAC), Lembaga Penggalakan Pelancongan Malaysia (TM) termasuklah Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM).

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Malaysia berbesar hati untuk menjadi tuan rumah *Regional Workshop on Compiling Tourism Statistics in Asia and the Pacific* di Institut Latihan Statistik (ILSM), Perak. Bengkel ini, yang dianjurkan oleh ESCAP, *United Nations World Tourism Organization (UN Tourism)* dan DOSM akan menjadi bukti komitmen kami dalam menggalakkan

kerjasama global dan kemajuan statistik. Antara faktor pemilihan Malaysia sebagai tuan rumah adalah berdasarkan faktor pengalaman Malaysia dalam membangunkan kerangka statistik pelancongan, antaranya melalui penyusunan Akaun Satelit Pelancongan dan pelaksanaan Rangka Kerja Statistik bagi mengukur Kelestarian Pelancongan.”

Beliau menambah, “Objektif bengkel ini adalah untuk melengkapkan peserta dengan kefahaman yang komprehensif mengenai pengeluaran statistik pelancongan dan untuk menggalakkan perbincangan mengenai metodologi yang diselaraskan dan amalan terbaik, selaras dengan rangka kerja statistik yang dipersetujui di peringkat antarabangsa untuk statistik pelancongan. Peserta akan lebih bersedia untuk memperkasakan pembangunan Sistem Perangkaan Pelancongan di negara mereka, termasuk dengan menjalankan kajian pelancongan yang berkaitan, penyusunan Akaun Satelit Pelancongan, serta pelaksanaan Rangka Kerja Statistik untuk Mengukur Kelestarian Pelancongan.”

Dengan menyokong penciptaan, promosi serta perkongsian amalan terbaik dan pengetahuan dalam kalangan komuniti statistik nasional, serantau dan antarabangsa untuk meneruskan agenda global, DOSM komited dalam bekerjasama dengan komuniti statistik Asia dan Pasifik untuk meningkatkan inisiatif pembinaan kapasiti statistik dan membantu negara anggota dalam meningkatkan sokongan statistik. Ini termasuk membantu dalam pelaksanaan dan pemantauan Agenda 2030 untuk Pembangunan Mampan dan menangani cabaran baharu.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah melancarkan OpenDOSM NextGen sebagai medium yang menyediakan katalog data dan visualisasi bagi memudahkan pengguna menganalisis pelbagai data dan boleh diakses melalui portal <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

FOR REGIONAL WORKSHOP ON COMPILED TOURISM STATISTICS IN ASIA AND THE PACIFIC

Malaysia hosts the Regional Workshop on Compiling Tourism Statistics in Asia and the Pacific

PUTRAJAYA, 10 May 2024 – Malaysia, represented by the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM), has been offered by Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) the opportunity to host the Regional Workshop on Compiling Tourism Statistics in Asia and the Pacific on 6 to 10 May 2024. The event was attended by 29 delegates from the member states of Asia and the Pacific regions which was Bangladesh, Bhutan, Kyrgyzstan, Maldives, Mongolia, and Nepal, alongside representatives from Malaysia. Malaysia was represented by participants from Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture (MOTAC), Tourism Malaysia (TM), as well as DOSM.

According to the Chief Statistician of Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, “Malaysia is privileged to host the Regional Workshop on Compiling Tourism Statistics in Asia and the Pacific at the Malaysia Statistical Training Institute (ILSM), Perak. This workshop, organised by Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP), the United Nations World Tourism Organization (UN Tourism) and DOSM will serve as a testament to our commitment in promoting global cooperation and the advancement of statistics. Among the factors for selecting Malaysia as the host country was based on Malaysia's experience in developing

a tourism statistical framework, including the compilation of the Tourism Satellite Account and the implementation of the Statistical Framework to measure Tourism Sustainability.”

He added, “The objective of the workshop is to provide participants with comprehensive insights into the production of tourism statistics and to foster discussions on harmonized methodologies and good practices, in line with the internationally agreed statistical frameworks for tourism statistics. Participants will be better equipped to foster the development of the System of Tourism Statistics in their country, including by conducting relevant tourism surveys, the compilation of the Tourism Satellite Accounts, as well as the implementation of the Statistical Framework for Measuring the Sustainability of Tourism.”

By supporting the creation, promotion, as well as sharing of best practices and knowledge among national, regional, and international statistical communities in order to further the global agenda, DOSM’s is committed to collaborate with the Asia and Pacific statistical community to enhance statistical capacity-building initiatives and assist the member countries in enhancing the statistical support. This includes assisting in the implementation and monitoring the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and addressing new challenges.

The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) has launched OpenDOSM NextGen as a medium that provides a catalog of data and visualisations to facilitate users' analysis of various data and can be accessed through <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.
