FCC ANNOUNCES DECEMBER 6, 2024 MEETING OF THE COMMUNICATIONS EQUITY AND DIVERSITY COUNCIL

GN Docket No. 17-208

In this Public Notice, the Wireline Competition Bureau announces that, consistent with the Federal Advisory Committee Act,¹ the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC or Commission) Communications Equity and Diversity Council (CEDC) will hold the third meeting of the CEDC under its current charter on December 6, 2024.² The agenda for the meeting will include greetings from FCC Chairwoman Rosenworcel's office, the introduction of a new Deputy Designated Federal Officer (DFO) for the CEDC, the introduction of new CEDC working group co-chairs for the Innovation and Access Working Group, updates from the working groups, and a discussion of working group plans going forward.

The December 6, 2024 CEDC meeting will be held in a hybrid manner, from 10:00 am to no later than 2:00 pm ET. The public may attend the meeting in person at FCC headquarters at 45 L Street, NE, Washington, DC. Additionally, the meeting will be available to the public for viewing via the Internet at <u>https://www.fcc.gov/live</u>. While the CEDC's meeting is open to the public, the FCC headquarters building is not open access, and all guests must check in with and be screened by FCC security at the main entrance on L Street. Attendees are not required to have an appointment but must otherwise comply with protocols outlined at: <u>https://www.fcc.gov/visit</u>.
