WIRELINE COMPETITION BUREAU ANNOUNCES EFFECTIVE DATES OF 2024 INCARCERATED PEOPLE'S COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES ORDER AND COMMENT DATES FOR 2024 INCARCERATED PEOPLE'S COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES FURTHER NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

Comments Due: October 21, 2024

Reply Comments Due: November 19, 2024

On July 22, 2024, the Commission released the *2024 IPCS Order*, implementing the Martha Wright-Reed Just and Reasonable Communications Act of 2022 and adopting comprehensive reforms and revised rules governing incarcerated people's communications services (IPCS).<sup>1</sup> The *Order* provides that it shall be effective 60 days after publication in the Federal Register and that delegations of authority shall be effective upon publication in the Federal Register,<sup>2</sup> except in cases where rule amendments require approval from the Office of Management and Budget (OMB).<sup>3</sup>

By this Public Notice, the Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) announces that the *2024 IPCS Order* was published in the Federal Register on September 20, 2024.<sup>4</sup> Accordingly, except for rules requiring OMB approval, all rules adopted in that Order will take effect on **November 19, 2024**. The portions of *2024 IPCS Order* delegating authority to the Bureau, the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau, and the Office of Economics and Analytics are effective **September 20, 2024**.

By this Public Notice, the Bureau also announces that the 2024 IPCS Further Notice was also published in the Federal Register on September 20, 2024.<sup>5</sup> The 2024 IPCS Further Notice requires that comments and reply comments be filed no later than 30 days and 60 days after publication in the Federal

Register.<sup>6</sup> Comments in response to the *2024 IPCS Further Notice* are due no later than **October 21**, **2024**, and reply comments are due no later than **November 19**, **2024**. The *2024 IPCS Further Notice* and the *2024 IPCS Further Notice Federal Register Notice* contain complete filing instructions.<sup>7</sup>
