## WIRELINE COMPETITION BUREAU SEEKS COMMENT ON POINT BROADBAND FIBER HOLDING, LLC'S PETITION FOR RELINQUISHMENT OF ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER DESIGNATION

The Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) seeks comment on a petition for relinquishment of Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) designation pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 214(e)(4) filed by Point Broadband Fiber Holding, LLC (Point Broadband).¹ Point Broadband seeks this relinquishment in connection with the approval and consummation of a transaction transferring a portion of its Rural Digital Opportunity (RDOF) authorized support and associated obligations to R.M. Greene, Inc. aka Beam (Beam).²

*Filing Requirements*. Interested parties may file comments on or before the **December 2**, **2024** and reply comments on or before **December 17**, **2024.**<sup>3</sup> All filings must refer to WC Docket No. 09-197.<sup>4</sup> Comments may be filed using the Commission's Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS).<sup>5</sup>

- *Paper Filers*: Parties who choose to file by paper must file an original and one copy of each filing.

The proceeding this Notice initiates shall be treated as a "permit-but-disclose" proceeding in accordance with the Commission's ex parte rules.<sup>6</sup> Persons making ex parte presentations must file a copy of any written presentation or a memorandum summarizing any oral presentation within two business days after the presentation (unless a different deadline applicable to the Sunshine period applies). Persons making oral ex parte presentations are reminded that memoranda summarizing the presentation must (1) list all persons attending or otherwise participating in the meeting at which the *ex parte* presentation was made, and (2) summarize all data presented and arguments made during the presentation. If the presentation consisted in whole or in part of the presentation of data or arguments already reflected in the presenter's written comments, memoranda or other filings in the proceeding, the presenter may provide citations to such data or arguments in his or her prior comments, memoranda, or other filings (specifying the relevant page and/or paragraph numbers where such data or arguments can be found) in lieu of summarizing them in the memorandum. Documents shown or given to Commission staff during ex parte meetings are deemed to be written ex parte presentations and must be filed consistent with rule 1.1206(b). In proceedings governed by rule 1.49(f) or for which the Commission has made available a method of electronic filing, written ex parte presentations and memoranda summarizing oral ex parte presentations, and all attachments thereto, must be filed through the electronic comment filing system available for that proceeding, and must be filed in their native format (e.g., .doc, .xml, .ppt, searchable .pdf).
