## **EFFECTIVE DATE FOR CYBERSECURITY LABELING FOR INTERNET OF THINGS RULES SET FOR SEPTEMBER 9, 2024**

### **PS Docket No. 23-239**

On March 15, 2024, the Commission released the *Cybersecurity Labeling for Internet of Things Report and Order* (Order),<sup>1</sup> establishing the framework for the Commission's consumer IoT labeling program. Certain of the rules adopted in the Order resulted in a new information collection under the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995.<sup>2</sup> The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has completed any necessary review under the Paperwork Reduction Act and approved the information collection associated with these rules on July 30, 2024 (OMB Control Number 3060-1328). On August 9, 2024, the Commission announced in the Federal Register both this approval and that the new rules would become effective September 9, 2024.<sup>3</sup>

By this Public Notice, the Federal Communications Commission's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau announces a September 9, 2024 effective date for the amendments to Part 8 of the Commission's rules addressing 47 CFR §§ 8.208, 8.209, 8.212, 8.214, 8.215, 8.217, 8.218, 8.219, 8.220, 8.221, 8.222.
