STREAMLINED RESOLUTION OF REQUESTS RELATED TO ACTIONS BY THE UNIVERSAL SERVICE ADMINISTRATIVE COMPANY

Pursuant to our procedure for resolving requests for review, requests for waiver, and petitions for reconsideration of decisions related to actions taken by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) that are consistent with precedent (collectively, Requests), the Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) grants, dismisses, or denies the following Requests.¹ The deadline for filing petitions for reconsideration or applications for review concerning the disposition of any of these Requests is 30 days from the release date of this Public Notice.²

NLC Christian Academy argues on reconsideration that its FCC Form 471 was late because its principal, not the person responsible for managing E-Rate at the academy, suffered an unexpected illness. Although our precedent states that a waiver is warranted when the E-Rate staff person suffers an "unexpected absence due to illness," we find good cause to waive the application deadline in this instance because it was the first year NLC Christian Academy was applying for E-Rate funding and it was unable to timely complete this process for the first time in the principal's absence due to an unexpected illness.

We find that WANRack, LLC was unable to complete implementation for reasons beyond its control and made good faith efforts to comply with Commission rules and procedures. We waive the special construction service delivery deadline and direct USAC to provide the applicant until June 30, 2025 to complete its special construction project.

For these Petitioners, we also waive any associated administrative or procedural deadlines, including the invoice filing deadline, that might be necessary to effectuate our ruling. *See also supra* note 5.
