## BY THE COMMISSION:

Pursuant to the Enhanced Wireless 911 Services Act, 1 the Public Service Commission ("Commission") is required to hold an annual hearing to determine the monthly rate of the Enhanced Wireless 911 Surcharge ("Surcharge") that is deposited to the 911 Service System Fund. 2 The Surcharge is subject to a statutory cap of 50 cents per wireless access line per month in Douglas County, and a statutory cap of 70 cents per wireless access line per month in the remaining counties in Nebraska. 3

The surcharge is currently set at 50 cents per wireless access line per month in Douglas County and 70 cents per wireless access line per month in the remaining counties in Nebraska.

The Commission finds that a hearing will be held to determine the monthly rate of the Surcharge for calendar year 2025 on **Tuesday, September 24, 2024 at 11:30 a.m. CST** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska and via videoconference.
