#### BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 7, 2024, Long Drive Luxury Shuttle, LLC, ("Applicant") Omaha, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers in Limousine service by van in and between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Lancaster, Buffalo, and Hall counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a> on June 5, 2024. On June 10, 2024, a protest was received from VIP Limousine, LLC ("Protestant"). On August 13, 2024, the protest filed by VIP Limousine, LLC was granted.
