On February 6, 2024, Comfort Care Services, LLC d/b/a Comfort Care Non-Emergency Medical Transport ("Applicant"), Bennington, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers in open class service by sedan, SUV, and van in and between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Lancaster, Washington, Dodge, Saunders, and Cass counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. HHS Designation: Yes.

Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 22, 2024. No protests were filed to the application.

On September 11, 2024, the Commission received notification that Applicant no longer wished to move forward with the Application.
