BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed October 15, 2024, Windstream IT-Comm, LLC of Little Rock, Arkansas,¹ ("Applicant") seeks to withdraw its certificates of authority to offer local and interexchange telecommunication services in Nebraska and to cancel its corresponding tariffs. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 22, 2024. No protests or interventions were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-4171, Applicant was given the ability to offer competitive local and interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. Applicant now seeks cancellation of its certificates of authority to offer competitive local and interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska, along with all applicable tariffs. Applicant states that its certificate is no longer necessary because it currently does not serve any customers in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Applicant's certificate of authority to offer competitive local and interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska should be cancelled, along with all applicable tariffs.
