BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 23, 2021, Steele Events, LLC d/b/a Steele Pro Party Bus, ("Applicant"), Lincoln, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by bus in special party service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. HHS Designation: No.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on July 9, 2021. No protests were filed; therefore, the application was processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.¹

The Commission entered an Order granting Application No. B-2037 on September 28, 2021. The September 28th Order stated that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission shall not be issued, "unless and until Applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time Applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to Applicant, be of no further force and effect."

On September 28, 2021, the Department sent Applicant a letter requiring Applicant to file with the Commission a Uniform Certificate for BI and PD ("Form E"), a completed copy of a description of vehicles form, submission of the appropriate fee payment, and a completed application form for Applicant's proposed rates and charges on or before 45 days from the effective date of

the Commission order granting the application. On March 8, 2022, Applicant filed the requested Rate Application. On September 29, 2022, Applicant filed the requested description of vehicles form. To date, the Commission has not received the requested Form E, vehicle fee payment, or Rate Application fee payment from the Applicant. The Commission attempted multiple times to contact Applicant regarding the need to file the requested information, but Applicant remains unresponsive.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that a deadline for action to be taken by Applicant in this docket should be set. If the Commission does not receive any communication or filing from Applicant concerning this application by **Tuesday, September 3, 2024**, the Commission will dismiss the application for failure to take timely action.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that a deadline for communication with the Commission by Steele Events, LLC d/b/a Steele Pro Party Bus, in Application No. B-2037, be, and is hereby, set for **Tuesday, September 3, 2024**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Steele Events, LLC d/b/a Steele Pro Party Bus, fails to take action by **Tuesday, September 3, 2024** in Application No. B-2037, the Commission will exercise its authority to enter an order dismissing the application.
