## **HEARING EXAMINER'S RULING**

## October 10, 2024

On April 29, 2024, Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc. ("CVA" or "Company"), filed an application with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") to increase its rates and charges and to revise the terms and conditions applicable to gas service ("Application"). On June 10, 2024, the Commission entered an Order for Notice and Hearing which, among other things, appointed a Hearing Examiner to conduct all further proceedings in this matter.

On October 7, 2024, counsel for CVA filed a Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Emily M. Farah ("Motion"). In the Motion, Thomas Borden Ellis, Esquire, of CVA, and a member of the Virginia State Bar, moved for the admission of Emily M. Farah, Esquire, to participate *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. Mr. Ellis represented that Ms. Farah is associated with NiSource Inc., the parent company for CVA, and is a member in good standing with the Pennsylvania and District of Columbia Bars. Mr. Ellis further represented that Ms. Farah will abide by all Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Commission and conduct herself as other attorneys admitted to practice before the Commission.
