HEARING EXAMINER'S RULING

November 1, 2024

On September 19, 2024, Virginia Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Energy Virginia ("Dominion" or "Company") filed with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval and certification of electric transmission facilities in Stafford County, Virginia ("Application"). Dominion filed its Application pursuant to § 56-46.1 of the Code of Virginia ("Code"), and the Utility Facilities Act, Code § 56-265.1 et seq.

On October 31, 2024, the Commission entered its Order for Notice and Hearing that, among other things, established a procedural schedule; directed the Commission's Staff to investigate the Application; provided opportunities for interested persons to participate in this case; and assigned a Hearing Examiner to conduct all further proceedings on behalf of the Commission and to file a final report.

On September 19, 2024, Dominion filed a Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Sarah B. Nielsen ("Motion"). Counsel for Dominion, Vishwa B. Link, Esquire, of McGuireWoods LLP, a member of the Virginia State Bar, moved the admission *pro hac vice* of Sarah B. Nielsen, Esquire, to practice before the Commission in Case No. PUR-2024-00170. Ms. Link stated Ms. Nielsen is an attorney associated with McGuireWoods LLP's office in Columbia, South Carolina. She stated Ms. Nielsen is a member in good standing of the South Carolina Bar. Ms. Link further represented, among other things, that Ms. Nielsen will abide by the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure and will conduct herself as other attorneys admitted to practice before the Commission.

Dominion's Motion is hereby granted. Accordingly,

IT IS DIRECTED THAT Sarah B. Nielsen, Esquire, is admitted *pro hac vice* in the instant proceeding.
