HEARING EXAMINER'S RULING


October 15, 2024

On August 30, 2024, Appalachian Power Company filed with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") a petition ("Petition") for approval of proposed revisions to its net energy metering program. On October 7, 2024, the Commission issued an Order for Notice and Hearing, which, among other things, docketed the Petition as Case No. PUR-2024-00161; established a procedural schedule for the case, including an evidentiary hearing set to convene on May 20, 2025; and appointed a Hearing Examiner to rule on any discovery matters or motions *pro hac vice* that may arise during the course of this proceeding.

On September 3, 2024, Appalachian Voices filed a notice of participation in Case No. PUR-2024-00161. On October 9, 2024, Appalachian Voices filed a Motion for Admission *Pro Hac Vice* of Emma Clancy ("Motion"). Counsel for Appalachian Voices, Josephus M. Allmond, Esquire, of the Southern Environmental Law Center, a member of the Virginia State Bar, moved the admission *pro hac vice* of Emma Clancy, Esquire, to practice before the Commission in Case No. PUR-2024-00161. Mr. Allmond stated Ms. Clancy is an attorney with the Southern Environmental Law Center in Charlottesville, Virginia. He stated Ms. Clancy is a member in good standing of the South Carolina and New York Bars. Mr. Allmond further represented, among other things, that Ms. Clancy will abide by the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure and will conduct herself as other attorneys admitted to practice before the Commission.

Appalachian Voices' Motion is hereby granted. Accordingly,

**IT IS DIRECTED THAT** Emma Clancy, Esquire, is admitted *pro hac vice* in the instant proceeding.
