HEARING EXAMINER'S RULING**November 19, 2024**

On October 15, 2024, Virginia Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Energy Virginia ("Dominion") filed with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") its 2024 Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP"). On November 15, 2024, Dominion filed a supplement to its IRP. On November 18, 2024, the Commission issued an Order for Notice and Hearing, which, among other things, appointed a Hearing Examiner to rule on any discovery matters or motions *pro hac vice* that may arise during the course of this proceeding.

On October 16, 2024, Appalachian Voices filed a notice of participation in Case No. PUR-2024-00184. On October 24, 2024, Appalachian Voices filed a Motion for Admission *Pro Hac Vice* of Emma Clancy ("Motion"). Counsel for Appalachian Voices, Nate Benforado, Esquire, of the Southern Environmental Law Center, a member of the Virginia State Bar, moved the admission *pro hac vice* of Emma Clancy, Esquire, to practice before the Commission in Case No. PUR-2024-00184. Mr. Benforado stated Ms. Clancy is an attorney with the Southern Environmental Law Center in Charlottesville, Virginia. He stated Ms. Clancy is a member in good standing of the South Carolina and New York Bars. Mr. Benforado further represented, among other things, that Ms. Clancy will abide by the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure and will conduct herself as other attorneys admitted to practice before the Commission.

Appalachian Voices' Motion is hereby granted. Accordingly,

IT IS DIRECTED THAT Emma Clancy, Esquire, is admitted *pro hac vice* in the instant proceeding.
