ORDER GRANTING MOTION

On August 8, 2024, the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") entered an Order Establishing Proceeding ("Procedural Order") wherein it established a proceeding to amend 20 VAC 5-340-10 *et seq.*, the regulations governing the shared solar program, to reflect updates to Code § 56-594.3 enacted during the 2024 session of the Virginia General Assembly. Among other things, the Procedural Order required Virginia Electric and Power Company ("Dominion" or the "Company") to serve a copy of the Procedural Order upon each of its existing shared solar customers and each of its registered solar subscriber organizations on or before August 26, 2024, and to file a certificate of service with the Commission on or before September 9, 2024.<sup>1</sup>

On August 26, 2024, Dominion filed a Motion for Extension of Time to Serve Customers by Mail and for Expedited Consideration ("Motion"). In its Motion, Dominion states that it timely provided the Procedural Order electronically, as directed, to 4,698 shared solar customers and registered subscriber organizations for which the Company has electronic contact information.<sup>2</sup> Dominion further states that, for its remaining 3,393 shared solar customers, it does not have electronic contact information and must provide the Procedural Order to these

customers by printing copies and sending them via U.S. mail.<sup>3</sup> According to the Motion, the Company's printing vendor has informed the Company that production of the required materials will take longer than expected, but that "[the vendor] is prepared to send the Procedural Order to the mail recipients no later than Friday, August 30, 2024.<sup>4</sup> The Motion thus requests that "the Commission extend the deadline to serve a copy of the Procedural Order on shared solar customers and registered subscriber organizations as directed in Ordering Paragraph (5) of the Procedural Order, by four days to August 30, 2024."<sup>5</sup>

NOW THE COMMISSION, upon consideration of the foregoing, is of the opinion and finds that Dominion's Motion should be granted and the deadline to serve a copy of the Procedural Order on existing shared solar customers should be extended until August 30, 2024. Except as modified herein, all other provisions of the Procedural Order remain in full force and effect.

Accordingly, it is so ORDERED, and this case is CONTINUED.
