ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

On August 1, 2024, Virginia Natural Gas, Inc. ("VNG"), filed with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application pursuant to Chapter 10 of Title 56 (§ 56-232 et seq.) of the Code of Virginia, and in accordance with the Rules Governing Utility Rate Applications and Annual Informational Filings of Investor-Owned Gas Utilities, requesting authority for a general increase in rates and to revise the terms and conditions applicable to its provision of natural gas service.²

On September 19, 2024, the Commission issued an Order for Notice and Hearing ("Order") that, among other things, directed VNG to give notice of its Application to interested persons and the public.³ Due to a drafting error, the Order stated that VNG is proposing to adjust the cap for the Conservation and Ratemaking Efficiency Program ("CARE") Rider rates in Rider D to \$0.17 "per 100 CCF of natural gas." The correct proposed CARE Rider rate cap is \$0.17 "per CCF of natural gas."

The Commission finds that pages 4 and 10 of the Order should be corrected, *nunc pro tunc*, to reflect the proposed cap for the CARE Rider is \$0.17 *per CCF* of natural gas. All other provisions of the Order shall remain in full force and effect.

Accordingly, IT IS SO ORDERED and this matter is CONTINUED.
