For an update of the 100 percent renewable energy tariff, designated Rider TRG, pursuant to §§ 56-577 A 5 and 56-234 of the Code of Virginia

ORDER GRANTING MOTION

On July 1, 2024, Virginia Electric and Power Company ("Dominion" or "Company") filed an application with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") pursuant to §§ 56-577 A 5 and 56-234 of the Code of Virginia for an annual update of the Company's voluntary 100 percent renewable energy tariff, designated Rider TRG.

On July 26, 2024, the Commission entered its Order for Notice and Comment ("Procedural Order"), which, among other things, established a procedural schedule directing the Commission Staff ("Staff") to file with the Clerk of the Commission a report in this matter ("Staff Report") on or before October 14, 2024.¹ The Procedural Order also directed the Company to file any response in rebuttal to the Staff Report on or before October 28, 2024.²

The Staff Report filing date of October 14, 2024, fell on a Commission holiday. Consequently, Staff filed its Staff Report the next business day, October 15, 2024.

On October 25, 2024, Dominion filed the Motion of Virginia Electric and Power Company for an Extension of Time to File Rebuttal Comments and for Expedited Consideration ("Motion"), wherein the Company requested that the Commission issue a ruling extending the

procedural deadline for the Company to file rebuttal comments to November 8, 2024.³ In its Motion, Dominion stated that the Company was initially served only the public version of the Staff Report by mail, and did not receive the extraordinarily sensitive version of the Staff Report until October 16, 2024.⁴ Dominion further stated that the Company wished to meet with Staff to discuss Staff's findings and recommendations to fully understand Staff's position, identify areas of agreement, and narrow any disputed issues in this case.⁵ Accordingly, Dominion stated, granting the Company's requested extension would allow the Company sufficient opportunity to meet with Staff and fully develop its rebuttal comments.⁶ The Company also stated that it had been authorized to represent that Staff and the Office of the Attorney General's Division of Consumer Counsel, the only Respondent in the case, take no position on the Company's Motion⁷.

NOW THE COMMISSION, having considered this matter, is of the opinion and finds that the Company's Motion should be granted and the procedural deadline for the Company to file rebuttal comments should be extended to November 8, 2024.

Accordingly, IT IS SO ORDERED, and this matter is CONTINUED.
