ORDER OF SETTLEMENT

Pursuant to § 56-265.30 of the Code of Virginia ("Code"), the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") is charged with enforcing the provisions of the Underground Utility Damage Prevention Act, Code § 56-265.14 *et seq.* The Commission's Division of Utility and Railroad Safety ("Division"), after having conducted an investigation of this matter, alleges the following concerning DSA Ventures LLC d/b/a Superior Fence & Rail of Richmond ("Company"):

(1) On or about August 23, 2023, the Company damaged a one-inch steel gas service line operated by Virginia Natural Gas, Inc., located at or near 119 Dumont Avenue, Norfolk, Virginia, while excavating.

(2) On the occasion set out in paragraph (1) above, the Company failed to take all reasonable steps necessary to properly protect, support and backfill the underground utility line, in violation of Code § 56-265.24 A.

(3) On or about September 25, 2023, the Company damaged a one-half-inch plastic gas service line operated by Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc., located at or near 31 Blossom Wood Court, Stafford County, Virginia, while excavating.



(4) This case is dismissed.
