ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR REVIEW

On August 21, 2024, Virginia Electric and Power Company, a Virginia Public Service Corporation, and its affiliates; Dominion Energy Services, Inc., Virginia Power Services Energy Corp., Inc., and Dominion Energy Fuel Services, Inc. (collectively, "Applicants"), filed an application ("Application") with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to Chapter 4 of Title 56 of the Code of Virginia ("Code"),<sup>1</sup> requesting approval of revised affiliate agreements governing the provision of fuel services and related affiliate transactions previously approved in Case No. PUR-2019-00137.

Pursuant to Code § 56-77, the Commission must act on the Application within 60 days of its filing or the contract or arrangement shall be deemed approved. However, the Commission may, by order, extend this period for up to an additional 30 days.

NOW THE COMMISSION, upon consideration of this matter and having been advised by the Commission Staff, is of the opinion and finds that the issues involved in the Application

will require additional time for review. Therefore, it is appropriate, pursuant to Code § 56-77, to extend the review period through November 20, 2024.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

(1) This case is hereby docketed and assigned Case No. PUR-2024-00153.

(2) Pursuant to Code § 56-77, the period of time for review of the issues presented by the Application is extended through November 20, 2024.

(3) This case is continued.
