ORDER OF SETTLEMENT

Pursuant to § 56-265.30 of the Code of Virginia ("Code"), the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") is charged with enforcing the provisions of the Underground Utility Damage Prevention Act, Code § 56-265.14 *et seq.* The Commission's Division of Utility and Railroad Safety ("Division"), after having conducted an investigation of this matter, alleges the following concerning H. W. Blankenship & Sons, Inc. ("Company"):

(1) On or about March 13, 2023, the Company damaged a one-inch plastic gas service line operated by the City of Richmond - Department of Public Utilities, located at or near 13170 Old Three Chopt Road, Henrico County, Virginia, while excavating.

(2) On the occasion set out in paragraph (1) above, the Company failed to take all reasonable steps necessary to properly protect, support and backfill the underground utility line, in violation of Code § 56-265.24 A.

As evidenced in the attached Admission and Consent document, the Company neither admits nor denies these allegations but admits to the Commission's jurisdiction and authority to enter this Order.

As a proposal to settle all matters before the Commission arising from the Division's allegations herein, the Company represents and undertakes that it will pay a civil penalty to the

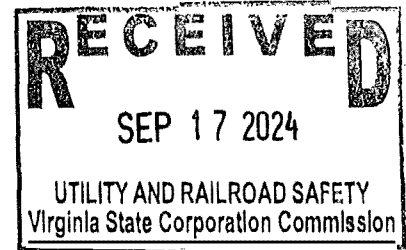
Commonwealth of Virginia in the amount of \$850 to be paid contemporaneously with the entry of this Order.

NOW THE COMMISSION, being advised by the Division and finding sufficient basis herein for the entry of this Order, accepts this settlement.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- (1) The captioned case is docketed and assigned Case No. URS-2024-00217.
- (2) Pursuant to the authority granted to the Commission by Code § 12.1-15, the offer of settlement made by the Company is accepted.
- (3) The sum of Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$850) tendered contemporaneously with the entry of this Order is accepted.
- (4) This case is dismissed.
