ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR REVIEW

On May 17, 2024, Virginia Electric and Power Company, and Dominion Energy Generation Marketing, Inc. ("DEGMI"), *et al.* (collectively, "Applicants"), ¹ filed a corrected Application with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to Chapter 4 of Title 56 of the Code of Virginia ("Code"), ² requesting approval of an Affiliate Support Services

Agreement under which DEV will provide certain enumerated support and administrative services to each Affiliate on an as-needed basis.

Pursuant to Code § 56-77, the Commission must act on the Application within 60 days of its filing or the Application will be deemed approved by operation of law. However, the Commission may, by order, extend this period for up to an additional 30 days.

NOW THE COMMISSION, upon consideration of this matter and having been advised by the Commission Staff, is of the opinion and finds that the issues involved in the Application will require additional time for review. Therefore, it is appropriate, pursuant to Code § 56-77, to extend the review period through August 15, 2024.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- (1) This case is hereby docketed and assigned Case No. PUR-2024-00050.
- (2) Pursuant to Code § 56-77, the period of time for review of the issues presented by the Application is extended through August 15, 2024.
